

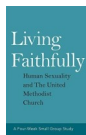
Welcome to Worship

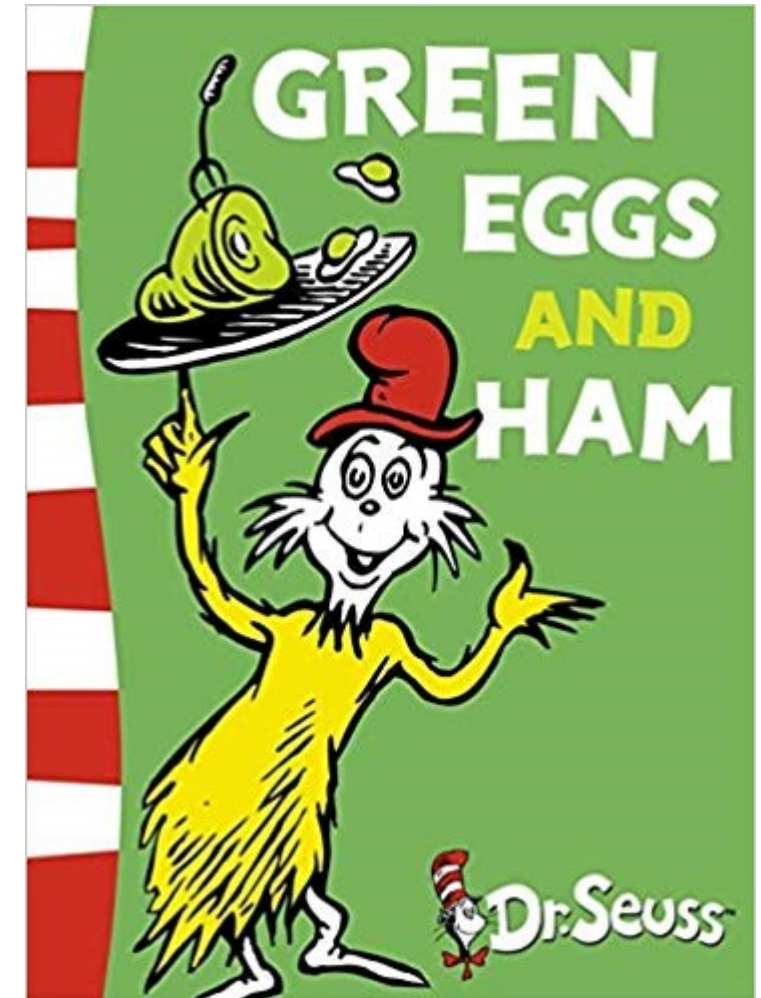
